




Department of History

On **02.08.2025**, students from the Department of History visited the **Kalugumalai Cave Temple** as part of our field trip to explore the rich historical and architectural significance of ancient cave temples. The objective of the trip was to provide students with an immersive experience of Tamil Nadu's ancient rock-cut architecture and to enhance their understanding of the region's history. During the visit; students observed and analyzed the **intricate rock-cut sculptures**, **inscriptions**, and **historical murals** that reflect the religious practices of the time. We also discussed the **historical context** of the temple, including its patronage by the **Pallavas** and later **Pandyas**, and the temple's architectural evolution.





On 26.08.2025, students from the Department of History visited Rameshwaram, a site of immense historical, cultural, and religious significance. This trip was organized to give students a deeper understanding of the rich heritage and history associated with the town, especially its role in Hindu mythology and Indian history. Rameswaram, located in the Pamban Island, is renowned for the Ramanathaswamy Temple, one of the holiest temples in India, and its historical connections to Ramayana and the Indo-Sri Lanka maritime route. The visit aimed at exploring the architectural marvels of the temple, the significance of the sacred waters, and the historical impact of the region on Indian culture and trade.
